Country Guide: Algeria

Used Household Goods and Personal Effects

Documents Required

- 1. Copy of passport
- 2. Original change of residence certificate issued in the origin country, stamped by the Algerian Consulate
- 3. Original detailed inventory issued in the origin country, signed, valued and stamped by the Algerian Consulate
- 4. Original certificate work delivered to the Algerian company
- 5. Original bill of lading (OBL) / air waybill (AWB)
- 6. Copy of resident permit / receipt of application for resident permit
- 7. Packing list
- 8. Contract work delivered by the Algerian company
- 9. Diplomatic franchise
- 10. Diplomatic card
- 11. Copy of the Consular card (to be certified by the Algerian Consulate at origin)
- 12. Consular deregistration certificate (from the Algerian Consulate at origin)
- 13. Original letter from the Algerian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA) requesting the owner of the goods to come back to Algeria (Algerian diplomat)
- 14. Original exemption certificate from the Algerian MoFA (Algerian diplomat)

Specific Information

- 1. A radiation certificate from the consular services abroad must also be provided.
- 2. Duty and tax exemption are only granted if valued inventory is less than 20,000 Euro.
- 3. One shipment only is authorized duty free (1 by sea and 1 by air, maximum).
- 4. All documents must be in French.
- 5. Customer must be present for Customs purposes.
- 6. Duty-free importation is only granted for a certain period; an extension must be applied to avoid penalties.
- 7. Imported household goods must be re-exported when leaving the country (non-Algerians).
- 8. Change of residence certificate must prove time abroad of at least 3 years and must be stamped by the Algerian Consulate at origin (returning citizens).
- 9. A diplomatic franchise can be obtained by the diplomatic organization in Algiers (diplomats).

Motor Vehicles

Documents Required

- 1. Original change of residence certificate (stamped by Customs)
- 2. Copy of diplomatic card
- 3. Original registration card and non-sale certificate
- 4. Valued inventory of the vehicle
- 5. OBL
- 6. Original value declaration for the vehicle signed and stamped (diplomats) (on diplomatic organization letterhead)
- 7. Letter of employment from diplomatic organization (diplomats)

Specific Information

- 1. The maximum allowable engine power is 10 HP.
- 2. Restrictions apply regarding importation of vehicles (age, power, etc.); contact agent for details.

Pets

Documents Required

- 1. Veterinary health certificate
- 2. Vaccination record

Specific Information

1. All cats and dogs imported into Algeria require a veterinary health certificate and proof that the animal is vaccinated against rabies.

Restricted/Dutiable Items

1. Appliances and electronics (one item each permitted duty free); invoices and receipts stating make, model and serial numbers are required on the detailed Inventory.

Prohibited Items

- 1. Firearms, explosives and ammunitions
- 2. Knives and deadly weapons
- 3. Illegal drugs
- 4. Precious metals
- 5. Plant and plant products
- 6. Pets and animals (authorization prior to import is required)
- 7. Alcohol
- 8. Drugs
- 9. Pornographic material
- 10. Gold and jewelry
