Country Guide: Hungary

Used Household Goods and Personal Effects

Documents Required

- 1. Copy of passport
- 2. Packing list
- 3. Bill of lading (BL) / express release / air waybill (AWB)
- 4. Resident permit / work permit / registration card / Hungarian ID
- 5. Detailed inventory in English, dated, valued, signed by the owner of the goods
- 6. Proof of living abroad a minimum of 1 year outside the European Union (company confirmation, utility bills, etc.)
- 7. Bank guarantee, if applicable

Specific Information

- 1. Imported items cannot be sold or leased.
- 2. The shipment of used goods is duty free for non citizens with a valid resident permit.
- 3. If the resident permit is valid for less than 1 year, a bank guarantee is required for the amount of the duty and other applicable shipment costs.

Motor Vehicles

Documents Required

- 1. Original registration card
- 2. Purchase invoice (must show purchase price and date of purchase)

Specific Information

- 1. The duty rate on cars depends on the place of origin.
 - The registration tax depends on the environmental class of the car plus a 27% value added tax.

Pets

Documents Required

- 1. Health certificate
- 2. Valid vaccination record

Specific Information

- 1. Pets must be identifiable through tattoo or an electronic identification system.
- 2. Pets may enter as checked baggage, as accompanied baggage, or as cargo.

Restricted/Dutiable Items

- 1. Firearms and ammunition (authorization from the territorial administration is required)
- 2. Alcohol and spirits should be sent separately from the personal effects shipment and are subject to tax.
- 3. Medication
- 4. Hunting weapons (authorization from the Ministry of Interior is required)
- 5. The following household goods may be imported duty free within the limits indicated:
 - Cigarettes (200), cigars (50), cigarillos (100), tobacco (500g)

Prohibited Items

- 1. Unlawful drugs
- 2. Narcotics
- 3. Pornography
- 4. Explosive materials
