Country Guide: Zimbabwe

Used Household Goods and Personal Effects

Documents Required

- 1. Original passport
- 2. Original bill of lading (OBL) / express release / air waybill (AWB)
- 3. Original inventory of all items (with serial numbers of electrical appliance to be written on)
- 4. Original packing list with values in USD and English
- 5. Freight invoice for customs clearance purposes
- 6. Resident / work permit / letter of employment

Specific Information

- Resident stamp / work permit / letter of employment / termination letter must explain details of new contract in Zimbabwe.
- 2. Returning citizens must have payslips for the past 2 years and a bank statement for last 6 months, along with an exit stamp of when the owner of the goods left (required for interview with customs) (returning resident).
- 3. Letter of appointment from organization in Zimbabwe (client is on work permit).
- 4. Those working on a work permit must have letter of appointment from organization.
- 5. Diplomats must have report order letter from the Embassy in Zimbabwe and a diplomatic ID card.
- 6. Goods should be only household goods and personal effects in order to be duty free.
- 7. Owners of the goods must be present during Customs clearance.
- 8. Customs will inspect all shipments.
- 9. Diplomats are exempt from duties.
- 10. Diplomats and returning citizens who live 2 or more years abroad are exempt from duties.
- 11. A duty exemption letter from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be obtained for diplomatic shipments.

Motor Vehicles

Documents Required

- 1. Original registration card
- 2. Certificate of ownership
- 3. Change of residence certificate
- 4. Copy of purchase invoice

Specific Information

- 1. Taxes on vehicle will depend on age, power, etc. (100% to 110% CIF).
- 2. The OBL must show the chassis number, engine number, cubic capacity, year of manufacture, brand, and model.

Pets

Documents Required

- 1. Certificate of vaccination
- 2. Zimbabwe veterinary health certificate
- 3. Import license (from the Director of Veterinary Services)

Specific Information

1. Permission from the Director of Veterinary Services is required prior to import.

Restricted/Dutiable Items

- 1. Plants and seeds and animals (agricultural certificate and phytosanitary certificate are required from the Embassy)
- 2. Medication
- 3. Firearms and ammunitions (authorization from the territorial administration is required)
- 4. Wine and spirits (2 L)
- 5. Cigarettes (200)

Prohibited Items

- 1. Narcotics
- 2. Explosive materials
- 3. Foreign soil
- 4. Pornography, defamatory or obscene publications
- 5. Cultural artifacts and other objects of cultural importance
 6. Henna
 7. Palm tree and any products thereof
